

For the financial year 2019-20, Under Component C of SANKALP titled, “**Improved Access and Completion of Skill Training for Female Trainees and Other Disadvantaged Groups**”, Assam Skill Development Mission had proposed three activities with respect to women, persons with disabilities (male members) and SC/ST male members to increase the respective percentages of beneficiaries completing training successfully. The details with respect to outcome for each of the activities is provided below:

Total amount to be given was INR 5,00,000/-	14 trainees benefited under the initiative. <u>A total of INR 14,000/- was disbursed by ASDM</u> directly into the bank accounts of the beneficiaries on their successfully passing third party assessments.
